### ABOUT THIS LEARNING OPPORTUNITY:

This course is designed to provide you with national certification to teach the First Aid/CPR with AED courses in your school and community (e.g. HCS 2020).

The First Aid Instructor Development Program (IDP) prepares you to become a nationally qualified St. John Ambulance First Aid and CPR instructor. This five-day modified program is for teachers applying in the Alberta Regional Professional Development Consortia through the Edmonton Regional Learning Consortium. The first 2.5 days will include instruction in the Enhanced First Aid course (the required pre-requisite). During the remaining 2.5 days, you will complete the St. John First Aid/CPR curriculum orientation module and the St. John Program Policy & Administration Orientation module.

Post-Course Requirements for Certification: Upon successful completion of the course, you will be required to complete a series of SJA coordinated team teaches as a student instructor on a Standard First Aid/CPR & AED course with an experienced instructor. Following the team teaches, student instructors will be monitored while teaching a Standard First Aid/CPR Level C & AED course. The instructor certification period is for three years.

### ABOUT THE FACILITATOR:

The session will be facilitated by a St. John Ambulance nationally certified Instructor-Trainer. St. John Ambulance has a proud tradition of setting high standards for the instruction of its programs. St. John Ambulance is a standing member of the Joint First Aid Training Standards Board of Alberta and is an accredited agency with Alberta Workplace Health & Safety.
