For the past ten years, researchers at the University of Kansas Center for Research on Learning (CRL) have been studying instructional coaching. CRL's instructional coaching model has been adopted by school districts and state agencies in more than 25 states across America. Participants will learn about the partnership philosophy that is the theory behind this approach, and the research that has been conducted on this model to coaching.

This workshop is designed to enable participants to answer the following questions: (a) What is an instructional coach? (b) How do coaches enroll teachers, identify coaching goals, model, observe, discuss data, and reflect about their practices? (c) What is the philosophy behind instructional coaching? (d) How can principals and coaches work together to ensure successful professional learning in schools?

### ABOUT THE FACILITATOR:

**Jim Knight** is a research associate at the University of Kansas Center for Research on Learning. He has spent more than a decade studying instructional coaching. Jim's articles on instructional coaching have been included in publications such as The Journal of Staff Development, Principal Leadership, and The School Administrator, and he has written two books on instructional coaching: Instructional Coaching: A Partnership Approach to Improving Instruction, and Coaching Classroom Management, written with Randy Sprick, Wendy Reinke, and Tricia McCale. Jim is frequently asked to guide professional learning for instructional coaches and has presented and consulted in more than 35 states, most Canadian provinces, and in Japan. He has also won several university teaching and innovation awards.
