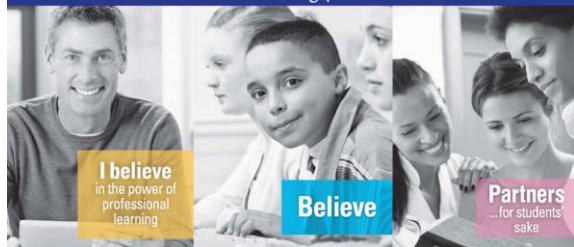

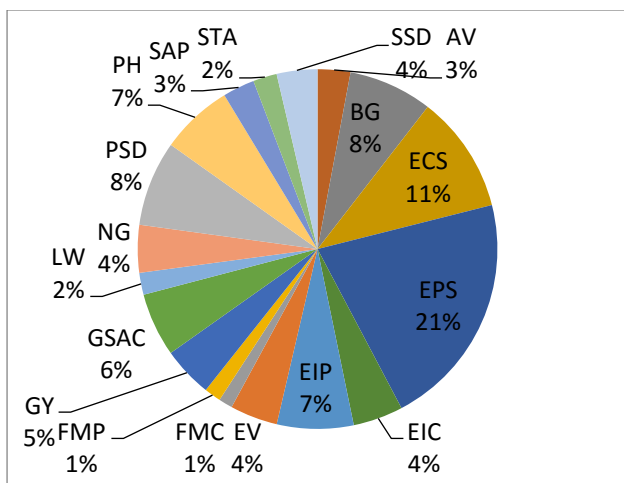
WHO WE ARE
